FOOD GROUPS



Citrus Fruits

Citrus fruit have a leathery rind outside, juicy segments inside, and sour or tart flavors.



Stone Fruits

Stone fruits have large "stones" or "pits" inside.



Root Vegetables

Root vegetables grow underground at the base of a plant.



Leafy Greens

Leafy greens are edible plant leaves and contain many nutrients.



Nuts

Nuts are seeds that have an oily flesh surrounded by a hard outer shell and are high in protein and fat.



Grains

Grains are small and hard dry seeds that grow on grass-like plants called cereals.

Brassicas

Brassicas (also called cabbage family, mustards, and cruciferous vegetables) are a group of plants that have their leaves, heads, or flowers eaten as vegetables.



Root Vegetables

Root vegetables are underground plant parts that are enlarged to store energy for the plant.



Legumes

Legumes are seeds of pod-producing plants and are high in protein and fiber.



Grains

Grains are small and hard dry seeds that grow on grass-like plants called cereals.



Citrus Fruits

Citrus fruit have a leathery rind outside, juicy segments inside, and sour or tart flavors.



Stone Fruits

A stone fruit (also called a drupe) is a fruit with one large "stone" or "pit" inside.
